

AUDIT KESELAMATAN UNIT PERPUSTAKAAN

26 JULAI 2023

Pada 26 Julai 2023 satu sesi Audit Keselamatan & Kesihatan Pekerjaan (OSHA) telah diadakan di unit perpustakaan. Seramai 2 orang auditor telah hadir menjalankan pemeriksaan yang meliputi keseluruhan skop keselamatan dan kesihatan perkerjaan. Antara pemeriksaan yang telah dilakukan adalah menyemak peti kecemasan bagi memastikan peti tersebut masih boleh digunakan atau sudah tamat tarikh luput. Selain itu juga, pihak auditor telah memeriksa pintu kecemasan dan alat pemadam api. Dapatan daripada pemeriksaan tersebut, pihak perpustakaan telah mendapat teguran berhubung dengan pintu keselamatan perpustakaan yang tidak berfungsi.



PERSIDANGAN TAHUNAN PERPUSTAKAAN MALAYSIA 2023

Pada 3-4 Ogos 2023 telah berlangsung Persidangan Tahunan Perpustakaan Malaysia 2023 yang bertempat di Dewan Al-Jazari PSA. Tema yang dipilih bagi tahun ini adalah "Masyarakat Digital Madani : Peluang Memacu Perubahan". Persidangan ini telah dirasmikan oleh Sasterawan Negara YBhg. Prof. Emeritus Dr. Muhammad Bin Haji Salleh, manakala ucapan aluan disampaikan oleh Presiden Persatuan Pustakawan Malaysia, YBrs. Dr. Ghazali Bin Mohamed Fadzil.

Persidangan ini dihadiri seramai 500 orang pustakawan dari pelbagai jenis perpustakaan termasuk Perpustakaan Negara, perpustakaan awam negeri, perpustakaan universiti awam dan swasta, perpustakaan politeknik, perpustakaan sekolah, perpustakaan komuniti dan desa, pakar maklumat, ahli akademik, pemain industri dan syarikat-syarikat yang menyediakan perkhidmatan dalam bidang perpustakaan, teknologi maklumat serta perkhidmatan digital.

Persidangan selama tiga hari ini merangkumi pelbagai acara, termasuk sesi pra-persidangan, 33 penyampaian kertas kerja, 1 sesi plenari, 14 pameran perdagangan dan inovasi dalam perkhidmatan perpustakaan dan maklumat, serta pertandingan Inisiatif Inovasi Perpustakaan Malaysia. Persidangan bermula dengan sesi pra-persidangan pada 2 Ogos 2023 yang diadakan di Perpustakaan Awam Selangor dengan tema *AI Revolution: Transforming Libraries for the Future*. Pra-persidangan ini menampilkan beberapa pembentang yang membincangkan mengenai AI dan aplikasinya dengan tajuk *The impact of AI on libraries: Quo vadis?*. Pra persidangan ini menyediakan kerangka perbincangan yang luas tentang bagaimana aplikasi AI akan memberikan peningkatan besar dalam operasi perpustakaan dan perkhidmatan, pro dan kontra AI dan juga meningkatkan relevansi perpustakaan dalam masyarakat digital yang sentiasa berubah. Lebih daripada 100 orang mengambil bahagian dalam pra-konferens ini.



PROGRAM SEMARAK MERDEKA PERINGKAT PSA



SIR CORNER BANK RAKYAT

Serambi Ilmu Rakyat atau dikenali sebagai Sudut SIR Corner merupakan sebuah Projek Khidmat Komuniti (CSR) Yayasan Bank Rakyat dalam bentuk Perpustakaan Digital yang berkonsepkan 80% digital dan 20% fizikal. Lebih 100 ribu koleksi digital boleh diakses melalui tujuh pangkalan data yang merangkumi subjek seperti perniagaan, ekonomi, kewangan serta bacaan umum. PSA menerima set fizikal "SIR Corner" berupa dua unit komputer dan satu set perabot diserahkan kepada PSA bagi memudahkan pengguna mengakses pangkalan data di "SIR Corner".



Ineffi cient energy use in buildings is both increasingly expensive and unsustainable. Indeed, the reduction of the energy consumption of existing buildings is as least as important as the design of new low-energy buildings. Controlling energy use is one thing, but it is important to assess or estimate it, and to understand the range of interventions for reducing its use and the methods for assessing the cost effectiveness of these measures. This book should appeal to building managers and facilities manager, and also to students on the increasing number of energy management modules in FE and HE courses. 'FIVE BILLION DAY' IN 1987, WAS MEANT TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE DATE ON WHICH THE WORLD'S POPULATION REACHED AN ESTIMATED FIVE BILLION PEOPLE, WHICH SUPPOSEDLY HAPPENED ON JULY 11 OF THAT YEAR (HENCE THE ANNUAL DATE FOR WORLD POPULATION DAY), AND LOOK HOW MUCH THE POPULATION HAS INCREASED SINCE THEN! POPULATION ISSUES COVER A LOT OF TERRITORIES, FROM FAMILY PLANNING, GENDER EQUALITY, AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS TO HUMAN RIGHTS CONCERN.

WORLD POPULATION DAY WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1989 BY THE GOVERNING COUNCIL OF THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME — UNDP. THE INSPIRATION FOR THIS HOLIDAY WAS THE PEAKING PUBLIC INTEREST IN THE CELEBRATION OF 'FIVE BILLION DAY' ON JULY 11, 1987. THIS ORIGINAL DATE WAS DECIDED TO BE SET AS 'WORLD POPULATION DAY' BY THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND RESOLUTION 45/21 MADE THIS OFFICIAL IN DECEMBER 1990.

WORLD POPULATION DAY SERVES TO HIGHLIGHT THE GROWING PROBLEMS THAT COME WITH A GROWING GLOBAL POPULATION. OVERPOPULATION IS A CRUCIAL ISSUE, ESPECIALLY CONSIDERING THAT WORLD RESOURCES ARE DEPLETING AT AN UNSUSTAINABLE RATE. AWARENESS ABOUT THE EFFECTS OF OVERPOPULATION ON DEVELOPMENT AND NATURE IS EMPHASIZED. THE INCREASING POPULATION ALSO SHEDS LIGHT ON HEALTH PROBLEMS FACED BY WOMEN DURING PREGNANCY AND CHILDBIRTH, MAKING THE NEED FOR FAMILY PLANNING, GENDER EQUALITY, AND MATERNAL HEALTH MORE IMPORTANT THAN EVER.

THE ISSUE OF POPULATION IS ALSO CAUSING STRAIN ON SOCIETY; HEINOUS CRIMES ARE HAPPENING MORE THAN EVER IN THE AREAS OF GENDER INEQUALITY AND HUMAN RIGHTS, ESPECIALLY IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES. LEADERSHIP IS ALREADY DOING A SUBPAR JOB AT TAKING CARE OF ITS CITIZENS, AND AS MORE PEOPLE COME INTO THE WORLD, VIOLATIONS SUCH AS HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND CHILD LABOR ARE INCREASINGLY BECOMING NORMAL.

What is the purpose of the International Youth Day?

International Youth Day is commemorated every year on 12 August, bringing youth issues to the attention of the international community and celebrating the potential of youth as partners in today's global society.



HISTORY OF INTERNATIONAL YOUTH DAY

In 1965 the United Nations General Assembly began making a concerted effort to impact the youth. They endorsed the Declaration on the Promotion among Youth of the Ideals of Peace, Mutual Respect and Understanding between Peoples. They began devoting time and resources to empower the youth by recognizing up-and-coming leaders and offering them resources to meet the needs of the world.

On December 17, 1999, the UN General Assembly endorsed the recommendation made by the World Conference of Ministers Responsible for Youth, and International Youth Day was formed. It was first celebrated on August 12, 2000, and ever since the day has been used to educate society. Mobilize the youth in politics, and manage resources to address global problems.

The day is often accompanied by major events. In 2013 an International Youth Conference was hosted by YOUTHINK, featuring many key speakers and an awards ceremony. More recent events have been hosted by the Indian Youth Cafe in Chennai. The theme for 2019 was "transforming education."

Last year, the theme of International Youth Day 2020 was "Youth Engagement for Global Action".

The aim of this theme was to call attention to the ways in which the participation of young people at the national and international levels is complimenting national and multilateral institutions and processes. Another important aim was to draw lessons on how their involvement in institutional politics can be increased.

TRADITIONS OF THE DAY

International Youth Day gives a platform to the voices of the youth. It engages youngsters and aims to take initiatives and actions that will increase opportunities for them.



The youth of the world faces different challenges and barriers to prosperity, depending on which part of the world they are living in. Young people living in developed and developing countries are more prone to facing mental- and social challenges, whereas young people living in underdeveloped countries face extreme problems rooted in a lack of more basic needs such as education, health, and employment.

These issues and challenges are widely discussed on local, institutional, and governmental levels. Seminars, training sessions, debates, discussion forums featuring influential figures as key speakers, fundraisers, and the distribution of educational material for informing and creating awareness take place on International Youth Day. Through a better understanding of the problems that are hurdles for youth development, policy changes can be more easily implemented.

Benjamin Franklin and Henry Ford are listed as left-handed, along with four of the last five U.S. presidents. England's Prince William is also a lefty. Michelangelo, Raphael, Leonardo da Vinci and Renoir made the list, as well.

3. Health perks
Left-handed stroke victims reportedly recover faster. While the reason is unclear, some believe it's due to left-handed people having to strengthen both sides of the brain to succeed in a right-handed world. Because many lefties are better at using their non-dominant hand, it's easier for them to recover from a stroke that damages one part of their brain.

4. Think it over
Left-handed people are said to be good at complex reasoning, resulting in a high number of lefty Nobel Prize winners, writers, artists, musicians, architects and mathematicians. According to research published in the American Journal of Psychology, lefties appear to be better at divergent thinking.

5. Join the club
For a quarter-century, the official left-handers club has hosted events dedicated to left-handed people across the globe. Activities include left-right sports matches, a left-handed tea party and pubs that use only left-handed corkscrews.

6. A sporting chance
Left-handers may have the edge in competitions where opponents face each other, such as tennis, baseball and boxing. This may be due to the fact left-handed athletes have more opportunity to practice against right-handed opponents.

7. Success stories
Word is, left-handed college graduates go on to become 26 percent richer than right-handed students. In addition, four of the five original designers of the Macintosh (Apple) computer are listed as lefties.

8. Shop 'till you drop
There are stores devoted to selling practical and novelty items to lefties. Online shops offer everything from left-handed mugs and kitchen sets to school and office supplies, clothing and "backwards" watches and clocks.

9. Very superstitious
According to myth, giving a toast with your left hand is the same as placing a curse on the person you're saluting. When St. Lucia's Arc was burned at the stake, depictions showed her as being left-handed, in order to appear more evil. Left-handers were also harshly discriminated against during the 18th and 19th centuries, and it was often "banned out" of them.

SEJARAH

Penubuhan Malaysia terdiri daripada Persekutuan Tanah Melayu, Borneo Utara/Sabah, Sarawak dan Singapura diadualkan diisytiharkan secara rasmi pada 31 Ogos 1963, bersamaan ulang tahun ke-6 kemerdekaan Persekutuan Tanah Melayu. Beberapa isu berkaitan dengan bantahan Indonesia dan Filipina memperlambatkan pengisytiharan hingga ke 16 September tahun yang sama. Penangguhan itu juga dibuat bagi membolehkan Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu membuat tinjauan umum di Borneo Utara dan Sarawak. Bagaimanapun, Borneo Utara dan Singapura masih lagi mendapat kemerdekaan daripada British pada 16 September 1963. Sarawak telah merdeka sebulan lebih awal pada 22 Julai 1963.

Pembentukan Malaysia kemudian diisytiharkan pada 16 September 1963, dan disambut sebagai Hari Malaysia. Sambutan kemerdekaan besar-besaran tetap diadakan pada 31 Ogos, tarikh asal kemerdekaan Persekutuan Tanah Melayu, manakala Hari Malaysia cuma menjadi cuti umum di Sabah. Bagaimanapun, mulai 2000-an terdapat sedikit ketidakpuasan hati di Malaysia Timur yang mendakwa sambutan hari Kebangsaan pada 31 Ogos terlalu bertumpuan Semenanjung Malaysia. Pada 2009, kerajaan memutuskan bahawa bermula 2010, Hari Malaysia 16 September disambut sebagai cuti umum persekutuan bersama-sama dengan Hari Merdeka pada 31 Ogos. Manakala bermula 2015, Menteri Ahmad Shabery Cheek menyatakan sambutan hari kemerdekaan mungkin disambut tanpa menyebut bilangan tahun agar tidak meminggirkan penduduk Sabah dan Sarawak.




We all need to stop taking water for granted and start improving the way we use it in our daily lives. What we eat, and how that food is produced all affect water. We can make a difference by choosing local, seasonal, and fresh foods, wasting less of it - even by reducing food waste, and finding safe ways to reuse it while preventing water pollution. Together, we can take water action for the future of food, people, and the planet.

Water is essential to life on Earth. It makes up over 50% of our bodies and covers about 71% of the Earth's surface. Only 3% of water is fresh, suitable for drinking, agriculture, and most industrial uses. Water is a driving force for people, economies and nature and the foundation of our food. Indeed, agriculture accounts for 72% of global freshwater withdrawals, but like all natural resources, fresh water is not infinite.

Rapid population growth, urbanization, economic development, and climate change are putting the planet's water resources under increasing stress. At the same time, freshwater resources per person have declined 20% in the past decades and water availability and quality are deteriorating fast due to decades of poor use and management, over extraction of groundwater, pollution and climate change. We risk stretching this precious resource to a point of no return.


Today, 2.4 billion people live in water-stressed countries. Many are smallholder farmers who already struggle to meet their daily needs, particularly women, Indigenous Peoples, migrants, and refugees. Competition for this priceless resource is increasing as water scarcity becomes an ever-increasing cause of conflict.

Around 600 million people who depend, at least partially, on aquatic food systems for a living are suffering the effects of pollution, ecosystem degradation, unsustainable practices and climate change.




